The age in which local cinemas ruled Brussels is over, but in the summer, that lost tradition does sometimes re-emerge, guaranteed for the past several years by PleinOPENair (late August) and Bruxelles fait son cinéma. There is now a sympathetic newcomer to the field: CinéCité. On 7 and 8 July, the organization is transforming the Josaphatpark/Parc Josaphat into an open-air cinema. The programme is as ambitious as it is varied, and features the imaginative Brussels youth film *Rosie & Moussa*, the excellent farming thriller *Petit paysan*, *Paterson* by Jim Jarmusch, and the celebrated road documentary *Visages Villages* by the street artist JR and the peerless Agnès Varda.
